Light golden color, aromas of honeysuckle and white peaches. A true Long Island original
- Brut Argyle '07 (Willamette Valley, OR) 53
A great vintage, sublime texture, look for white cherry and green apple

- Viognier Seven Hills '08 (Columbia Valley, WA) 36
Hints of Creamsicle, butter and honey suckle with balancing acidity
- Sauvignon Blanc/ Semillon Cadaretta '09 (Columbia Valley, WA) 37
This wine is made for oysters. Fruit forward with notes of grass and pepper
- Sauvignon Blanc Peju '09 (Napa Valley, CA) 43
Intense tropical notes of pineapple and guava, this wine goes on and on
- Arneis Ponzi '10 (Willamette Valley, OR) 49
Tropical fruits on the nose, soft vanilla palate before a big bright finish
- Chardonnay Mer Soleil '10 (Monterey, CA) 49
Unoaked with ripe pineapple it captures the crisp mineral essence of a classic Chablis-Style
- Chardonnay Chamisal '10 (Central Coast, CA) 39
Full pears, peaches, bright citrus, crisp vanilla, aged in stainless steel this is pure Chardonnay
- Chardonnay L'Ecole No. 41 '10 (Columbia Valley, WA) 43
Cooler growing season means backbone! Tropical fruits, complex and rich
- Grenache, Marsanne, Roussanne Hearst Ranch '09 (Paso Robles, CA) 43

Great new green winery, hand-harvested fruit, light color, wonderful complexity
- Pinot Noir Carmel Road '09 (Monterey, CA) 41
Salinas Valley's cool winds make this a lovely Pinot, elegant black cherry and roses
- Pinot Noir Belle Vallee '08 (Willamette Valley, OR) 47
Old world meets new. Blueberry and cherry up front followed by earth and smoke
- Pinot Noir Schug '08 (Carneros, CA) 50
Spicy cherries and strawberries reminiscent of Burgundy. A long elegant finish
- Pinot Noir Au Bon Climat '07 (Santa Maria Valley, CA) 66
Famous producer makes unforgettable wines. Pepper and soft berry fruits
- Syrah Qupe '09 (Santa Ynez, CA) 37
Round and soft with lots of stewed fruit and notes of black olive
- Syrah/ Grenache/ P Sirah Arizona Stronghold '09 (Cochise, AZ) 49
Rhône style from high above the Mexican border. Fig and spicy with hints of lavender
- Carignane/Zin/Mouvedre Trinitas Mysterium '08 (Napa, CA) 39
Plush cherry and berry fruit, broad, jammy palate, low acidity. So drinkable

- Cabernet Franc Steele '09 (Nevada County, CA) 39
Just enough cellar time to allow this beautiful example of cabernet franc to really sing
- Tempranillo Abacela '08 (Southern Oregon, OR) 51
Lots of chewy fruit with butterscotch, tobacco and subtle spice on the nose
- CabSauv/PetitVerdot/Merlot Guenoc "Langtry" '07 (Lake County, CA) 54
All about complexity. Earthy and rich, filled with cassis, spice and leather. Full and smooth
- Zinfandel Marietta '09 (Sonoma, CA) 48
Big rich berry fruit, black pepper and cinnamon with ample acidity and smooth tannins
- Zinfandel Four Vines "Biker" '09 (Paso Robles, CA) 51
Blackberry and anise. Great mid-palate wine with a silky smooth finish
- Cabernet Sauvignon Smith & Hook '09 (Central Coast, CA) 34
Big, full-bodied cabernet. Deep rich black fruit flavors with a long, lingering finish
- Cabernet Sauvignon Airfield '10 (Yakima, WA) 40
Blackcurrant and rich oak with lots of berries. The only vineyard built on an old airfield.
- Cabernet Sauvignon Big Ass '09 (Napa Valley, CA) 44
Full-on tannin kung-fu with mouth-smacking blackberry and currants
- Malbec Pax Americana "Stag's Leap" '06 (Napa Valley, CA) 67
Ultra smooth. All of the soft juicy red fruit and rose petal you could want

PORT

Noval "Black Port" 9/ 78 (750ml)
This Ruby port brings bright berry flavors with peppermint that cuts the sweetness

Warre's Tawny 10 Yr 10/ 58 (500ml)
Vibrant with a soft amber color and raspberry, caramel, toffee and dried apricot flavors

Guenoc '06 Petite Sirah Port (Guenoc Valley) 13/ 51 (375ml)
Very sweet, with flavors of honey and black cherry. Wine Enthusiast Rating: 92

Duck Walk Vineyards "Blueberry Port" (Southampton, NY) 12/ 35 (375ml)
A strong nose of blueberries, medium sweet to taste, with hints of blueberry/raspberry jam

DESSERT WINE

Saint Supery Moscato '05 (California) 10/ 47 (375ml)
Vibrant color the aromas here abound with rich apricots, peach blossom and crisp acidity

Chateau Grand Traverse "Botrytis" Riesling (Traverse City, MI) 15/ 65 (500ml)
A concentrated dessert wine with delicious notes of peach skin, tropical fruit and black tea

Wolffer Late Harvest Chardonnay (Sagaponack, NY) 18/ 72 (375ml)
Apricot, kiwi, honey and a mineral lime balance a frisky acidity that jumps from the glass

Edmeades "Alden Vineyard" Late Harvest Zinfandel 10/ 49 (375ml)
Tobacco, cherries, honey and pine fill the nose in this luscious, chewy, rounded, wine
